Campus Designated Funds

Support of these funds permits residents to benefit from additional programs and services, and staff to benefit from educational and training opportunities. All funds assist in maintaining the high quality of care that our residents and their loved ones expect and depend upon.

Eph Cohen Nurse Education Fund

This Fund is designated for educational initiatives for the Nursing Department.

Esther Jacobs Atlas Employee of the Year Fund

Supported and maintained by the Yaverbaum family, this Fund provides two annual recognition gifts to Employees of the Year – one gift to an employee from the Nursing Department, and another to an employee from non-Nursing or Support staff.

Stanley Sykes House Fund

This is a Fund whose assets may be used for campus beautification.

The Hiken Fund

This permanently restricted Fund renders its corpus untouchable and its interest and earnings are for Benevolent Care at the Residence.

Women's Giving Circle

The Women's Giving Circle provides an opportunity for donors to touch the lives of our women residents in a collective way. Women's Giving Circle funds make a direct impact on their health and well-being by investing in programs and initiatives. Your Women's Giving Circle gift can significantly enhance the quality and range of our female residents' care.
