To Family, Friends & Staff of The Campus,

Unfortunately, we were notified today of two positive test results from the staff testing performed on 4/22. Both staff had been previously vaccinated.

Contact tracing was performed as soon as we became aware of the test results. Residents who were identified through contact tracing to have potentially been exposed were rapid tested today and their families were notified of their negative test results. Several staff who were determined to be in close contact with the positive team members are now self-quarantining.

All buildings on The Campus are now considered to be in “yellow” phases. This affects several activities.

Visitation. Due to the possible exposures, the skilled nursing facility will not have in person visitation until May 10. The exception to this will be compassionate care and end of life visits. The personal care home will resume visitation after a full round of negative testing is completed.

Dining. Communal dining has been temporarily halted in both buildings as well. The PCH dining room will be reopened on May 7 if no new positive test results are received.

Activities. Group activities in both buildings have been discontinued and will resume when regulations allow based on testing. With the improved weather, staff in both buildings will assist in helping residents enjoy outdoor time in small groups.

All staff, regardless of vaccination status, are now required to wear N95 masks and face shields until further notice.

While this is certainly frustrating for all, it is not completely unexpected as the county positivity rate has risen. We will continue to work diligently to keep residents and staff safe. Feel free to reach out to any of us with questions.

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
