To Family, Friends & Staff of The Campus,

The Campus is continuing monitoring and mitigating the COVID-19 outbreak that began on 12/22/2021. Since the last letter, the skilled nursing facility (SNF) has had 3 more positive employees. This brings the SNF to a total of 24 positive employees in various departments, 9 of which are currently on quarantine. The personal care home (PCH) currently has 4 positive staff members quarantined at home, and a total of 7 positive employees since the beginning of the outbreak.

Resident positive counts remain the same, 1 in the SNF and 1 in the PCH. The resident in the SNF will be considered recovered beginning today and taken off transmission-based precautions.

We continue to follow the DOH and CDC guidelines for infection control and risk mitigation to keep staff and residents as safe as possible. Dauphin County positivity rate is currently at 38%, however what we have noticed internally is that people do not test positive until days 3-5 post symptom onset. Therefore, we want to remind you to continue being diligent with visitation and refrain from coming in if you experience any cold or flu-like symptoms. Initial symptom for most of our positive staff has been a scratchy throat. If you are able to refrain from visiting until the positivity numbers start to go down, we recommend you do so. If you must visit, please ensure that you are wearing a well-fitting face mask and socially distance from both residents and staff. Your support in this is extremely important to minimize exposure and spread.
